In an effort to improve our safety measures, we will be using a number system this year for car riders. Each parent will have a car tag that hangs from their rearview mirror. As you pull up on Fifth Street (as usual), we will call out cars by numbers to avoid using student names. Tags were created at back to school night, but if you were unable to attend, one will be created for you on the first day of school in the carline. Car riders will get two (2) hang tags and backpack tags with their number. If you have a student at both Moccasin and Ottawa, you need to get your car tag at Moccasin.

CHECK THOSE HEADS!



A friendly reminder that as we return to school, you must be active about checking your child's head for Head Lice. Lice are crawling insects that live only on the human head. They do not jump

or fly, but they're easily transmittable through close contact or by sharing personal items such as combs, hats, or other recently warn personal belongings.

If your student contracts Head Lice, please contact the school to acquire a form that you'll need to fill out and sign before returning your child back to school.
