Tonight at 11:59 p.m. Berrien County Health Department will rescind the order requiring the use of face masks by individuals in pre-kindergarten through grade 12 in educational settings.

For Buchanan Community Schools, this means that starting tomorrow, September 30, 2021, students, staff, and visitors will have the option of wearing masks just as we did during the first week of school.

Masks will still be required on all school buses based on federal mandates.

Mitigation measures such as masks, being socially distanced, and washing hands are still highly recommended and encouraged and have been proven to decrease the spread of the virus.

We will continue to implement our policies and our Return to Learn plan to ensure a safe and healthy environment is available for all students.
