In-person learning has been shown to provide the greatest benefit to students, and ensuring this can happen consistently and safely during the upcoming school year has been deemed a priority for Berrien County Schools.

The 2021-2022 Return to Learn Plan provides detailed guidance to ensure that COVID-19 prevention and mitigation measures are implemented in a way that fosters optimal learning environments while simultaneously ensuring health and safety for students and staff in Berrien County. This plan was collaboratively developed by Berrien County Superintendents with the support of the Berrien County Health Department to ensure that all Berrien County School Districts have an aligned and detailed plan for a successful return to the classroom this fall.

Please Note: This plan may change and evolve as knowledge changes surrounding current and potential variants and availability of vaccination for younger age groups.



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Based upon the community transmission level, as determined by the BCHD, Buchanan Community Schools, in consultation with BCHD, will determine the number of mitigation strategies to implement to foster optimal learning environments while simultaneously ensuring the health and safety of students and staff.

The transmission level will be determined at the end of the day of Friday of each week. Any adjustments to mitigation strategies will be implemented as soon as feasible or at a date determined by local, state, or federal administration.



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The district will comply with any and all local, state, and federal mandates/orders. When there are no local, state, or federal mandates/orders, staff, students, and visitors will have the option to utilize as many mitigation measures as desired including wearing masks.

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Isolation and Quarantine (Staff & Students)

Work with BCHD & RESA to support robust case investigation and contact tracing. Provide educational support for students and families who are impacted by isolation and quarantine. Isolation and quarantine will adhere to local public health requirements and operating procedures. Close contact identification will be supported by the school for classroom and athletic-based close contact identification.

NOTES: Close contact exclusion will be determined by current school operations and policies currently in place for masking and social distancing. For example:

- → If districts do not require face masks → Close contact with 6 ft of positive individuals will be quarantined for 10 days from the last date of contact. Fully vaccinated individuals do not quarantine unless symptomatic.
- → If districts require face masks → Close contacts within 3 ft of positive individual will be quarantined for 10 days from the last date of contact. Individuals 3 to 6 ft may continue to attend school as long as they do not have symptoms. Fully vaccinated individuals are not quarantined unless symptomatic.

The district will follow the most current isolation and quarantine guidelines available.

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Student Illness

Parents are not to send children to school given our communicable disease policy (Policy Link / Administrative Guideline Link)

Students exhibiting the following symptoms shall remain home or excluded from school until the student is symptom-free for 24 hours without the aid of medication.

- Fever (temp over 100.4) or feeling feverish/chills
- Cough
- Sore throat
- Runny or stuffy nose (congestion)
- Muscle or body aches
- Headaches
- Fatigue (tiredness)
- Vomiting and diarrhea

Students exhibiting the following symptoms which are strong indicators of COVID-19

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shall remain home or excluded from school for 10 days unless a negative COVID-19 test result or a doctor's note stating the student may return to school is provided to school authorities.

- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- New loss of taste or smell
