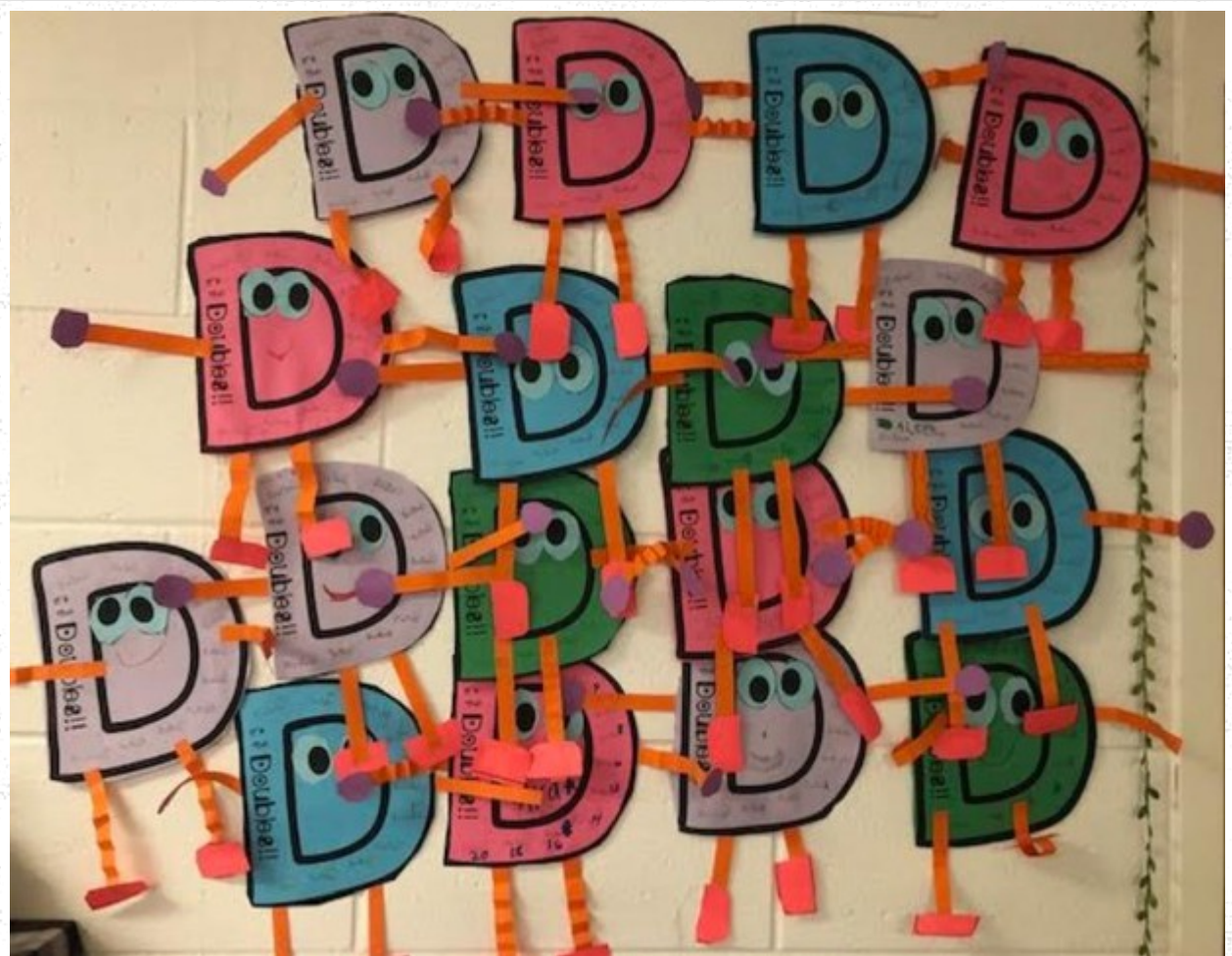
DEPOSIT DAY! 11/18

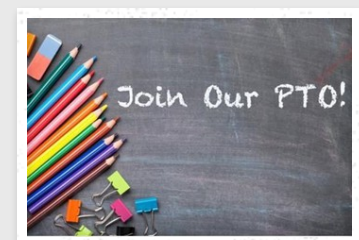

Meetings will be held inside, at this time, masks required, but that may change come January.

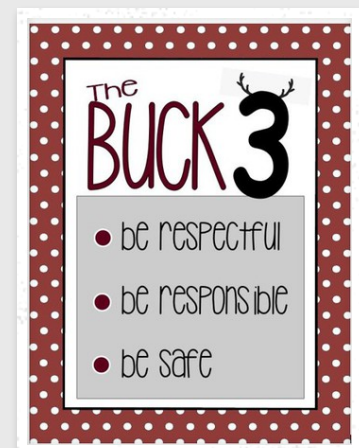

DISMISSAL/TRANSPORTATION CHANGES
