This letter is intended to update you regarding the threat at Buchanan High School which happened on Monday, December 6, 2021. The student making the comment was removed from school on Monday and has not returned. Our local police department has been handling the investigation.

Buchanan Community Police have been supportive by providing surveillance of our buildings throughout the day.

Our building leadership continues to observe and connect with students throughout the high school.

Once more, school safety is our number one priority. I also want to commend those students again who shared this information with school leadership. We encourage students to report anything suspicious. Further, students may confidentiality and anonymously call or text the Herd Hotline at 269-409-1153 to make a report.

As always, in addition to reporting threats or suspicious activity to school staff, everyone has access to the confidential reporting tool, <u>OK2Say</u>. Anyone can report tips confidentially on criminal activities or potential harm directed at students, school employees, or schools. Tips can be submitted 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.
