These threats include calling in bomb threats, making school shooting threats, among other threats. All of these threats warrant our concern.

We take any and all threats to our students, staff, and buildings seriously!! We work closely with local, county, and state law enforcement agencies and have robust partnerships with them to assure our schools continue to be safe. Prevention and early intervention are the keys to stopping threats.

But, we cannot do this alone! Please take time to speak to your children about the proper and improper use of social media. Please let them know about the consequences of engaging in behavior that threatens students, staff, and our schools. These threats are NOT a joke and are not taken lightly by any of us charged with keeping our schools safe and operating. Students face serious consequences for making threats to schools, even so-called "fake threats". These consequences include suspension or expulsion from school and possible legal action for making ANY threat to which schools and law enforcement must respond.
