Meetings will be held inside, at this time, masks required, but that may change come January.



PRESCHOOL TEAM

Our preschool team consists of Mrs. Chase and Mrs. Fox, Mrs. Monsma, and Ms. Shaner. We have two Great Start Readiness Program preschool classes. Mrs. Chase and Mrs. Monsma are the lead teachers, Mrs. Fox and Ms. Shaner are classroom assistants. The program is half day with AM and PM classes with no more than 16 students in each. There are certain factors and criteria that need to be met to qualify for this program. Curriculum in preschool addresses various developmental skills, such as gross motor, fine motor, literacy, mathematics, vocabulary, and verbal expression. DISMISSAL/TRANSPORTATION CHANGES

We want to make sure every single student gets out the door and home safely. Please remember the following:

- If you are picking your child up as a walker, they will be dismissed at the doors by our front office.
